**For customers who must fill their maintenance medications
in a 90-day supply**

Your plan includes a new maintenance medication program called Cigna 90 Now. Maintenance medications are taken regularly, over time, to treat an ongoing health condition. **With Cigna 90 Now, maintenance medications have to be filled in a 90-day supply at one of the 90-day retail pharmacies in your plan's network, or Cigna Home Delivery Pharmacy^{SM,*}**

Depending on your benefit plan, you're typically allowed up to three fills in a 30-day supply before you have to fill a 90-day supply.** At that time, if you haven't switched to a 90-day supply, your plan won't cover the cost of the medication.

Depending upon plan design, market conditions, the extent to which manufacturer payments are shared with your plan and other factors as of the date of service, the preferred brand medication may or may not represent the lowest-cost brand medication within its class for you and/or your plan.

If your plan provides coverage for certain prescription drugs with no cost-share, you may be required to use an in-network pharmacy to fill the prescription. If you use a pharmacy that does not participate in your plan's network, your prescription may not be covered, or reimbursement may be limited by your plan's copayment, coinsurance or deductible requirements.
